Vigil for Drug Overdose Victims

- On Wednesday, November 2nd, Columbia County will have a **vigil ceremony** for the 19 Columbia County residents lost to fatal drug overdoses in 2016. It will be held at the Columbia County Courthouse at 6:00 PM. The hope of this event is to "begin to raise awareness, start a conversation, spread hope, and lead to activism and education on the part of all of Columbia County's residents. The life of an addict is no less valuable than anyone else, and as we continue to move forward, we sincerely hope that the Town and its residents recognize that the souls being lost to this epidemic are our mothers and fathers, brothers and sisters, sons and daughters, and not just a nameless, faceless junkie."
