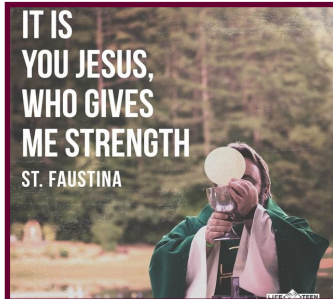
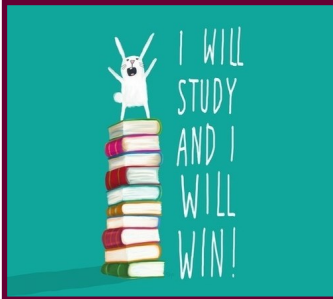

### Saturday, December 10-Friday, December 16
