Penny Wars!

- This semester, Catholic Campus Ministry is raising money for the **Jude Zayac Foundation**, an organization that exists to support SIDS (Sudden Infant Death Syndrome) research and to enrich the lives of local children in honor of Jude Zayac, who passed away at three months old from SIDS. In order to raise money, CCM will be having a **penny war**. Two bottles will be set up in the family room of the Newman House (353 E 2nd St, 4th house on the right down the hill from Carver Hall), one for boys and one for girls. For every penny put into either jar, the respective team will receive a positive point. For every nickel, dime, quarter, dollar, etc., put into either jar, the respective team will receive negative points. The points equal the same as the coin's value. Girls can put negative points into the boys' jar and the boys can do the same for the girls. The goal is to get a good competition going and raise as much money as possible. This fundraiser will occur during Lent, from March 1st to April 12th, as a way to focus on the Lenten aspect of almsgiving. The winning team will get free Dollar Dinner on April 19th and will receive bragging rights...so put your game faces on and save up your change!
