Friday, September 16

- The **University Mass** will take place at 6:00 PM at St. Columba Church. St. Columba is located on the corner of Third & Iron Streets and is a short walk from campus. If you'd like to **walk to the church with others**, a group will leave from the steps of Carver Hall at 5:40 PM. If you'd like to **sing with the choir**, practice begins each Sunday at 5:00 PM at St. Columba. **Reconciliation** is also available in the church before Mass each Sunday from 5:15-5:45 PM.
