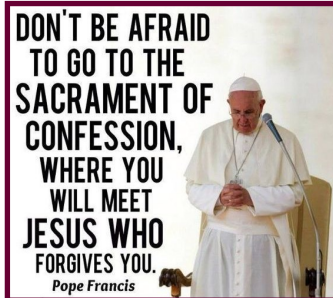

Upcoming Activities

Friday, September 30

- **Mass** will take place at 12:30 PM in the Newman House chapel.
- From 1:00-4:00 PM, there will be **Eucharistic Adoration** in the Newman House chapel. You may come at any time for however long you wish.

Sunday, October 2

- Join us to take part in **Life Chain!** Life Chain is an annual event that takes place throughout the US and Canada. It is a peaceful and prayerful public witness in which people stand in prayer, often with pro-life signs, in a line ('chain') along the road. It is a visual statement of solidarity by the Christian community that the Church supports the sanctity of life from the moment of conception to the moment of natural death. Meet at the Newman House at 12:45 PM to walk down to the town fountain together. Silent prayer and witness will take place from 1:00-2:00 PM.
- The **University Mass** will take place at 6:00 PM at St. Columba Church. St. Columba is located on the corner of Third & Iron Streets and is a short walk from campus. If you'd like to **sing with the choir**, practice begins each Sunday at 5:00 PM at St. Columba. **Reconciliation** is also available in the church before Mass each Sunday from 5:15-5:45 PM.

- There will be the opportunity for **Reconciliation** in the Newman House chapel from 6:00-6:30 PM. **Mass** will then take place at 6:30 PM in the Newman House chapel.

Tuesday, October 4

- **Mass** will take place at 6:30 PM in the Newman House chapel.
- A **Group Discussion Night** will take place at 7:00 PM as part of the Busy Person's Retreat going on this week. All are welcome to come to the discussion night, however—participation in Busy Person's Retreat is not required. We will spend time sharing with one another about our faith and what it is like to be a Christian in our day to day lives. The Group Discussion Night will replace the Women's Group meeting for this week.
